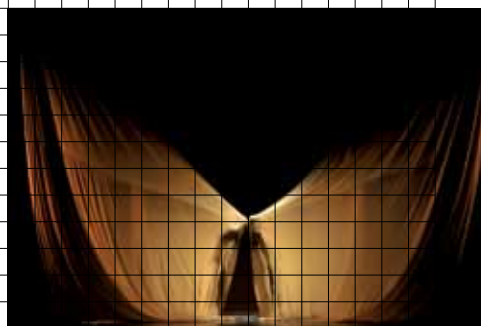

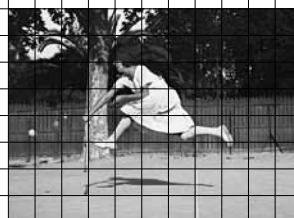

European Athletics Championships

The athletics capital
Barcelona lives sport to the full with a calendar of world-class competitions including 20 major events from a variety of sporting disciplines. This year's main highlight is the 20th European Athletics Championships Barcelona 2010, which will take place from 26th July to

1st August. The European Athletics Championships will be held at the same venue that thrilled the world 18 years ago during the 1992 Olympic Games: the Estadi Lluís Companys, one of the great architectural gems that presides over the area known as the "Olympic Ring" on Montjuïc Hill.

It will be a thrilling week during which, for the first time in the history of the Championships, five of the races will be held completely in the street: the walking competitions and the marathons. Some 1,600 athletes from 48 countries, and more than 40 disciplines, will keep their rendez-vous with Barcelona. The city will experience a week devoted to athletics, but will also give its visitors the chance to enjoy its complete cultural, culinary, retail and recreational offering. All sports fans who buy event passes for the championships will be entitled to important discounts on the Barcelona Bus Turístic or on visits to the attractions close to the Olympic Stadium on Montjuïc, such as CaixaForum, the Mies van der Rohe Pavilion, the Poble Espanyol and the Museu Nacional d'Art de Catalunya. There are tickets to suit every pocket (from 21 to 600 €), and the passes are practically tailor-made. For further information: www.bcn2010.org

The exhibition not only celebrates the last 25 years of this internationally renowned artist's career; it also gives the viewer the opportunity to understand the mystery, adrenalin and personal uncertainties

Is it possible to combine sightseeing with some of the best performances from the world's theatre and dance scene? If you're in Barcelona in July, the answer's yes. This is when the city hosts its summer extravaganza, the Barcelona Grec Festival, its most important cultural event. Some of the world's leading performers visit the festival, and this year Japan is the featured country.

The Barcelona Grec Festival also gives you the chance to sample the newest and most surprising creations from

the Japanese performing arts scene, but you can also enjoy performances by theatre and dance companies from Spain and around the world. The range of entertainment is complemented by a programme of concerts to suit all audiences, from the classical to the cutting-edge. There will be emotive evenings, such as the one promised by Joan Manuel Serrat who will be performing *Hijo de la luz y de la sombra*, his tribute to the poet Miguel Hernández.

Other highlights include performances where you don't have to understand the words to enjoy them to the full, such as *Wild Cursive*, the latest work by the Cloud Gate Dance Theatre of Taiwan.

Inspired by Chinese calligraphy, the work seeks to recreate the process of writing through the movement of the dancers.

If you're looking for a performance rooted in flamenco, you'll have to buy tickets for the thrilling show *Lluvia*, by the dancer Eva Yerbabuena, which reflects on the theme of melancholy, or go to see the flamenco dancer María Pagés and the contemporary dancer Sidi Larbi Cherkaoui in *Dumas*, which explores their shared origins in the field of dance.

There are other excellent Spanish dancers who are ready to show their talent during the festival, among them Marta Carrasco, whose stunning performance *Dies Irae* spans the fields of dance and theatre and includes musical pieces such as Mozart's *Requiem*. Iago de Pericot, uses Bach's music in his dance performance *La venus de Willendorf*, which reflects on violence in our time through the medium of dance.

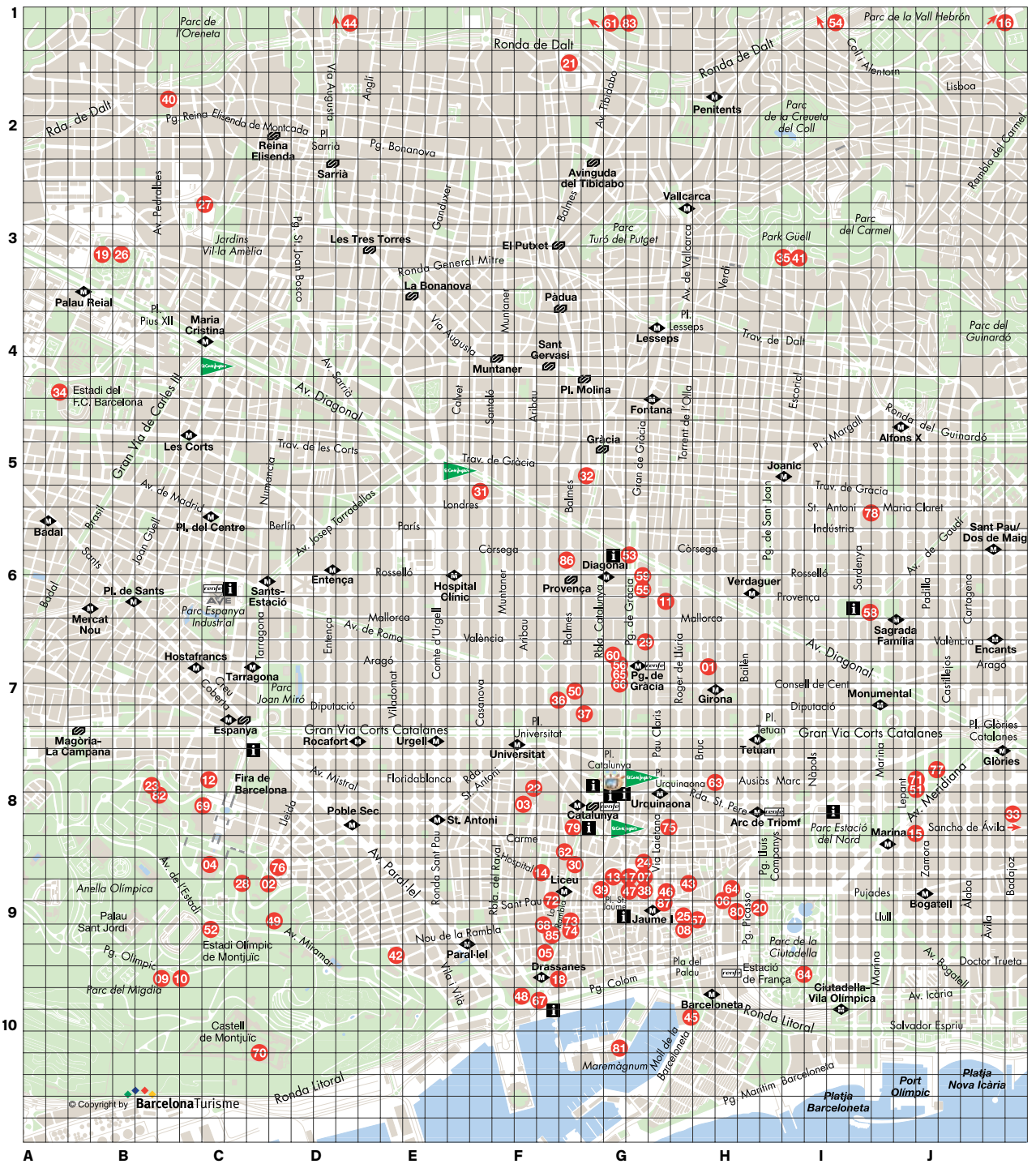
